- Explain the concepts of X, Y and Z, discussing their relevance to specialised translation
- Discuss some of the main strengths and weaknesses associated with using X for specialised translation
- Give an overview of the types of X that can be used by translators working on specialised texts
- Explain the notion of X and discuss its importance for specialised translation
- Explain the differences between X and Y as resources (or tools) that can be used for specialised translation, and discuss their pros and cons
- Discuss in what circumstances, how and for what purposes X can be used effectively by professional translators



Sample exam questions for module B

- Explain the differences and similarities between the notions of X and Y with reference to the development and use of translation tool Z
- What are the main benefits and advantages of using translation tool X from the point of view of professional translators?
- Discuss some of the main problems and limitations involved in relying on X as a resource/tool that can help translators working on specialised texts
- Explain how X and Y typically work and how they can be profitably used by professional translators dealing with specialised texts
- Give an overview of the ways in which X (and Y) can support specialised translation
- Describe a realistic scenario in which using X would be particularly useful for a translator, and explain why this is the case
