

SIMPLE FUTURE (I WILL...) IN SPANISH

How to form simple future:

Regular verbs:

Verb in infinitive (ending in AR, ER o IR)
+ (add ending)

I	...é
You	...ás
He/she	...á
We	...emos
You guys	...éis
They	...án

Example (I will...)

Bailar (to dance)
Bailar + ás = Bailarás (you will dance)

Barrer (to sweep)
Barrer+ é = Barraré (I will sweep)

Dormir (to sleep)
Dormir+ án = Dormirán (they will sleep)

Irregulars:

Poner (to put).	Pondr.
Decir (to say).	Dir.
Salir (to go out)	Saldr.
Hacer (to do)	Har.
Poder (to be able to).	Podr.
Tener (to have).	Tendr.
Querer (to want).	Querr.
Valer (to be worth).	Valdr.
Saber (to know)	Sabr.
Venir (to come)	Vendr.
Haber (aux)	Habr

Example (I will...)

Yo pondré
Yo diré
Yo saldré
Yo hare
Yo podré
Yo tendré
Yo querré
Yo valdré
Yo sabré
Yo vendré

Note:

It applies to the verbs
that have these verbs
inside, too.

For example:
Mantener (to mantein)
Mantendr-

Entretener (to entertain)
Entretendr-
